This letter acknowledges receipt by the Department of Environmental Protection of your written request for records under Pennsylvania Right-to-Know Law ("RTKL"), 65 P.S. §§ 66.1 *et seq.* Your request was received by this office on April 15, 2009. A copy of your request is enclosed.

Under the provisions of 65 P.S. §902(b)(2), you are hereby notified that your request continues to be reviewed for the reasons specified below. Therefore, this agency will require up to an additional thirty days, i.e., up to May 21, 2009, within which to provide a final written response to your request.

- Your request is under legal review which is necessary to determine whether a requested record is a "public record" for purposes of the RTKL.
- The extent or nature of the request precludes a response within the required time period. Specifically, records responsive to your request may be stored in a remote location and cannot be retrieved timely.

Documents responsive to your request, once identified, will be collected in the Department's Pottsville District Mining Office. Once our file collection and review is complete, you will be provided with access to the responsive documents. We will notify you if there are any charges associated with responding to your request.
