Right-to-Know Officer:

I am requesting a document that pertains to the A/C Fuels permit to operate a fly ash dump, Coal Surface Mining Permit NO. 54980201.

The particular item in this permit that I inquiring about is (B. EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL FACILITIES). The permit lists a sediment control facility @ Latitude 40°/55'/28" by 76°/00'/15". When I Googled this coordinates I arrived at a swimming pool located at a nearby residential residence.

Obviously the Pottsville District Mining Office failed to properly investigate this permit before granting a permit that would allow the dumping of coal fly ash.

This Right-to-Know law request was made and ignored in the past by the Pottsville District Mining Office. I have included one of many requests mad in the past.

Under the Right-to-Know law that was established on January 1, 2009 I am requesting the following:

1. A document that shows the amended permit and the location of real sediment control facility.
