Right-to-Know Officer:

On January 31, 2003 my residence at 345 West Blaine Street McAdoo, PA was severely damaged by a state mandated sewer installation.

The 1st of two blasts that occurred January 31, 2003 on or around 9:28 AM with traffic stopped in both directions on West Blaine Street; busy state road. The blast and resulting damage were witnessed by many because of my homes location. Three key witnesses were brought to the attention of Richard Parsons, DEP; Richard Lamkie, DEP and Dennis A. Whitaker, Esq.

Richard Parsons, DEP and Richard Lamkie, DEP promised myself and Patti Dreyer that these individuals would be interviewed to record what they witnessed; this was said to us numerous times by both DEP investigators.

Rod Sergent from Spotts, Stevens and McCoy, Inc. was standing only a few feet from my home during the blast of January 31, 2003. He failed to step forward during the initial investigation conducted by Richard Parsons and Richard Lamkie.

On June 6, 2003 @ 9:15 AM Patti Dreyer spoke with Richard Lamkie on the phone and explained that the blast records were wrong and that Rod Sergant was present at the time of the blast and witnessed everything. Richard Lamkie was unaware of this prior to this time and promised Patti Dreyer that he would interview Rod Sergent.

Under the Right-to-Know law that was established on January 1, 2009 I am requesting the following:

1. The document of the testimony by Rod Sergent; recorded during the interviews conducted by either Richard Parsons; Richard Lamkie or Dennis A. Whitaker, Esq.
