Right-to-Know Officer:

Since November of 2004 I have reported to the Pottsville District Mining Office pollution leaking from the coal fly ash stored at the A/C Fuel coal fly ash dump.

It is a matter of record that this office refused to take plant, animal, surface water and/or soil samples from this dump.

On April 12, 2009 I toured the wet lands located directly below this dump and noticed several survey markers and what appears to be a hole dug in the middle of the coal fly ash lagoon located at this site. The hole dug appears to be a ground perk test. There is also several PVC piping laid out in a fashion as to monitor and/or collect the water as it flows from the erosion of this dump.

Under the Right-to-Know law that was established on January 1, 2009 I am requesting the following:

1. Test results from surface water samples collected by DEP from the A/C Fuel site from April 13, 2008 to April 13, 2009.
2. Test results from ground samples collected by DEP from the A/C Fuel site from April 13, 2008 to April 13, 2009.
3. Test results from plant samples collected by DEP from the A/C Fuel site from April 13, 2008 to April 13, 2009.
