Right-to-Know Officer:

On April 20, 2009 I received a message on my answering machine from "Diane from the Borough of McAdoo".

The message stated that my request was compiled and that the cost was \$14.50 @.25 cents per copy.

Thank you for your efficiency in this request, I did not realize that there were 58 documents available from my three simple Right-to-Know Law request.

I have revised my request to help cut the cost for my family. Please notify me of the new cost that would also reflect mailing this document to my place of residence.

Under the Right-to-Know law that was established on January 1, 2009 I am requesting the following:

1. One copy of a letter that I sent to McAdoo Borough Council informing council that many local residences could still have property damage and were never properly notified to inspect their homes for damage.
2. One copy of the document/letter sent to *all* the residents of the Borough of McAdoo instructing them to properly inspect their homes for damage from the illegal blasting of Marks Contracting, LTD.
3. One copy of the letter sent to Steven Dreyer in reply, after notifying McAdoo Borough Council that properties within the borough were never properly inspected for damage.
