**Re: Right-to-Know Law Request**

**Right-to-Know Officer:**

After reviewing the hundreds of photos that I have on file from the A/C Fuel coal fly ash dump I could not find a layer of fly ash and Culm.

I do not agree with the DEP and their decision to use coal fly ash as fill for strip mines. I feel that the dump should be lined until a suitable and safe alternative is found.

If DEP insists on dumping coal fly ash than I believe that the current rules and regulations should be followed to the letter of the law.

Under the Right-to-Know law that was established on January 1, 2009 I am requesting the following:

1. The document covering the proper disposal of coal fly ash at the A/C Fuel coal fly ash dump, Coal Surface Mining Permit NO. 54980201. I am requesting the document that would specify the method of disposal, i.e.: four feet of ash to one foot of Culm or suitable fill.
